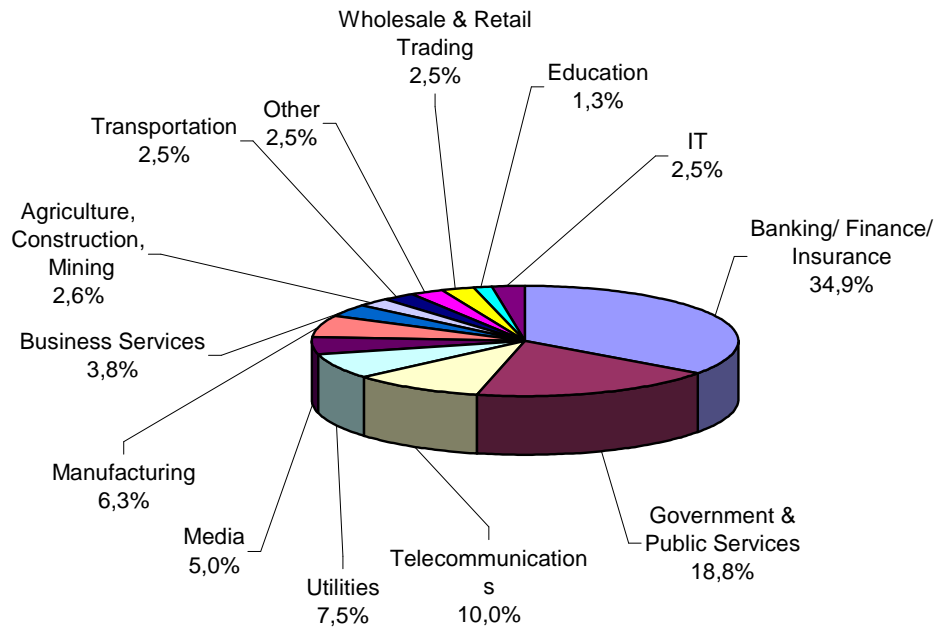

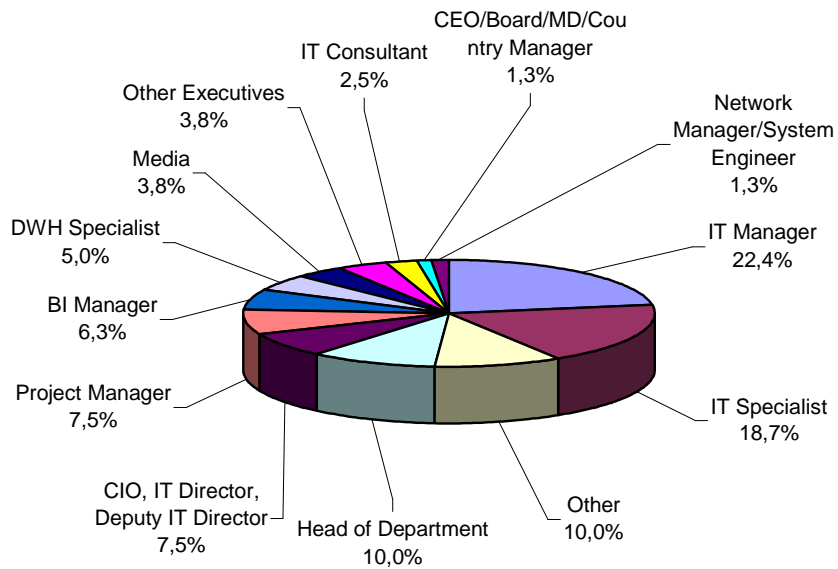

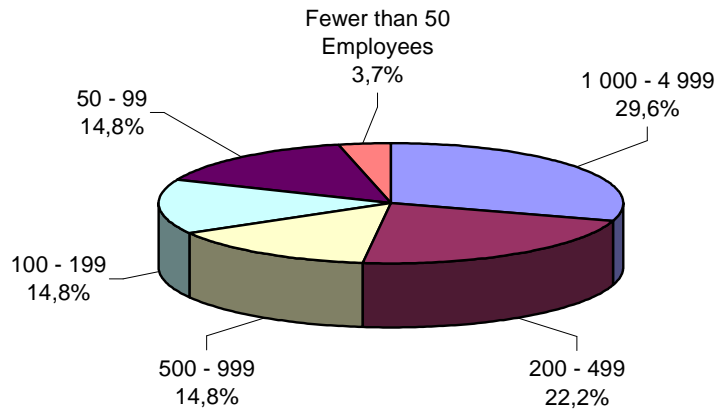
#### Demographics of Attendees by Vertical



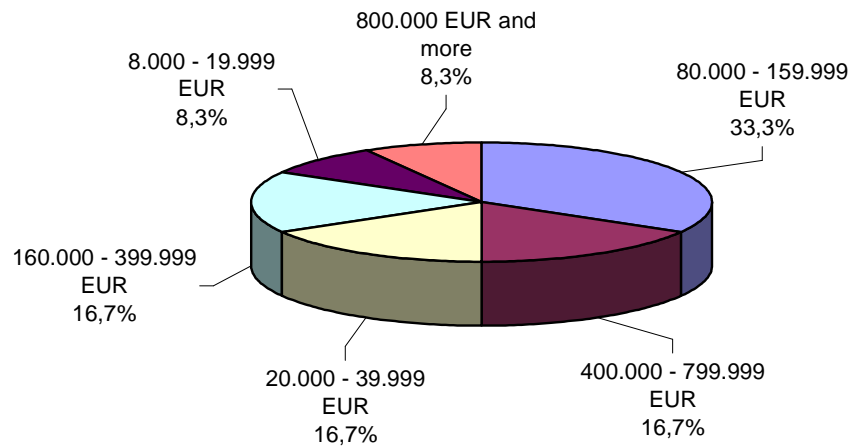
## Demographics of Attendees by Position



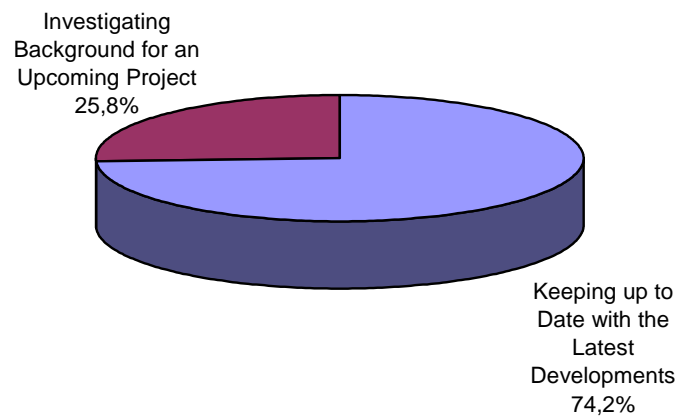
## Demographics of Attendees by Company Size (34.6% of Attendees Responded)



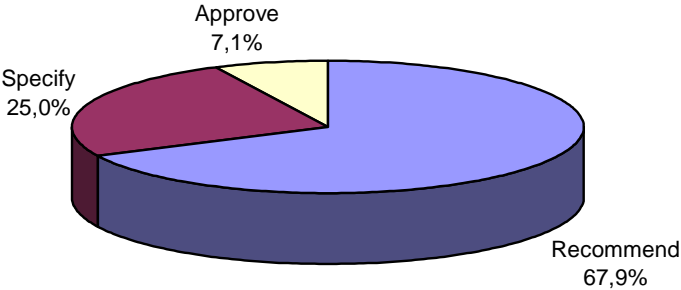
## Demographics of Attendees by Size of Company Budget (15.4% of Attendees Responded)
